

RESOLUTION NO. 62-275

RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING VOTE OF ELECTION, DECLARING ESTABLISHMENT OF CHRISTIAN VALLEY PARK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, SETTING FORTH THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID DISTRICT, THE NAMES OF THE PERSONS ELECTED DIRECTORS THEREOF, AND THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH SAID DISTRICT IS FORMED

WHEREAS, there has been filed with this Board of Supervisors of Placer County a petition signed by registered electors within the unincorporated territory described therein equal in number to at least ten per cent (10%) of the number of votes cast within said territory at the general election next prior to the filing of said petition, which petition prays that the territory described therein be organized as a community services district pursuant to the provisions of Title 6, Division 2 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said petition states the proposed name of said district, sets forth the proposed boundaries of said district, and states the purposes set forth in Section 61600 of the Government Code for which the district is to be formed, and states the number of members of the Board of Directors of said district to be three (3); and

WHEREAS, following the filing of said petition this Board did at its next regular meeting fix a time and place for hearing said petition, not less than twenty (20) nor more than sixty (60) days after the date of such meeting; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing of said petition was published in the manner and for the time required by Sections 61105 and 61106 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, on the final hearing of said petition this Board of Supervisors did fix the boundaries of said proposed district, and in so doing did exclude from the district all lands which would not be benefited by the proposed budget, and did include in said district all lands as will be benefited thereby, and on said final hearing this Board did designate as the name for said proposed district "Christian Valley Park Community Services District"; and

WHEREAS, this Board did on said final hearing call an election to be held not less than forty (40) days nor more than sixty

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days from the date of said final hearing for the purpose of determining whether or not said district shall be formed and for the purpose of determining whether or not said district shall be formed and for the purpose of selecting persons who shall serve as the first directors of said district; and

WHEREAS, this Board did cause notice of said election to be published in the manner and for the time required by Sections 61122 and 61123 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly held and conducted within said proposed district October 23, 1962, and said election was in all respects conducted and held in the form and manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, this Board, having met this 30th day of October, 1962, to canvass the vote at said election and declare the result thereof, and such canvass having been duly made;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND DECLARED:

1. That said election was held and conducted in all respects and particulars as required by law;

2. That the total number of votes cast in said election at the polling place provided therein was 10; that the number of absentee votes was none;

3. That the measure voted upon in said formation election and the number of votes received for and against the measure are as follows:

4. That the persons voted for at said election to fill the offices of members of the Board of Directors, and the number of votes given to each person running for said offices, respectively, were as follows:

5. That a community services district of the name of "Christian Valley Park Community Services District" has been duly established, with the boundaries stated in the resolution calling said election, which boundaries are particularly set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;

6. That FRANK CARR ALLEN, FRANCIS VICTOR BROWN and HARVEY DENVER STERNER have received a plurality of the votes cast for three (3) members of said Christian Valley Park Community Services District and are hereby declared elected for the terms to be ascertained according to the provisions of Section 61201 of the Government Code of the State of California;

7. That said Christian Valley Park Community Services District is formed for the following purposes:

A. To supply the inhabitants of the district with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection and recreation.

B. The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage, waste and storm water of the district and its inhabitants.

C. The collection or disposal of garbage or refuse matter.

D. Protection against fire.

E. Public recreation by means of parks, including aquatic parks and recreational harbors, playgrounds, swimming pools or recreation buildings.

F. Street lighting.

G. Mosquito abatement.

H. The equipment and maintenance of a police department or other police protection to protect and safeguard life and property.

I. To acquire sites for, construct, and maintain library buildings, and to cooperate with other governmental agencies for library service.

J. The opening, widening, extending, straightening and surfacing, in whole or part of any street in such district, and subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.

K. The construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and works incidental to the purposes specified in subdivision J, subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.

8. That this resolution and order shall be entered in the minutes of this Board of Supervisors according to the provisions of Section 61127 of the Government Code of the State of California and the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to file certified copies of this resolution and order as statements of the creation of said district with the Recorder of the County of Placer, the Assessor of the County of Placer, the Secretary of State of the State of California, and the State Board of Equalization of the State of California.

9. That the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed on behalf of this Board to issue a certificate of election to each of the successful candidates.

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., running thence from said point of beginning, Easterly along the North line of said Southwest quarter 1320 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 10; thence Southerly along the West line of said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter 1320 feet more or less, to the Southwest corner of said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter; thence Easterly along the South line of the North half of the South half 3960 feet, more or less, to the East line of said Section 10; thence Southerly along the East line of said Section 10 and the East line of Section 15, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., 2640 feet, more or less, to the Northeast corner of the South half of the Northeast quarter of said Section 15; thence Westerly along the North line of the East half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 15 for a distance of 660 feet; more or less, to the Northwest corner of said East half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 15; thence Southerly along the West line of said East half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 15 for a distance of 1320 feet more or less to the South line of said Northeast quarter of said Section 15; thence Westerly along said last named line to the centerline of the County Road; running thence along the centerline of said County Road in a Southerly and Easterly direction to the intersection thereof with the East line of the Southeast quarter of Section 15, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M.; thence Southerly along the East line of the Southeast quarter of Section 15, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., to the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 14, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M.; running thence Easterly along the North line of said Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 14 to the intersection thereof with the centerline of said County Road and running thence Southerly and Easterly along said County Road centerline to the East line of the said Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 14; running thence Southerly along said last named line and the East line of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 23, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., to the Southeast corner of the said Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 23; running thence Westerly along the South line of said Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 23 and the South line of the North half of the North half of Section 22, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., for a distance of 3690 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 22; running thence Northerly along the West line of said Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 22 to the Northwest corner thereof; and running thence Westerly along the South line of said Section 15 for a distance of 2640 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of said Section 15; thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 15 for a distance of 1320 feet, more or less, to the Southeast corner of the North half of the Southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M.; thence Westerly along the South line of said North half of the Southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., for a distance of 2640 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of said North half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 16; thence Northerly along the North-South centerline of said Section 16 and of Section 9, Township 13 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M., for a distance of 5280 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of the South half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 9; thence Easterly along the North line of said South half of the Southeast quarter of said Section 9 2640 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of the South half of the Southwest quarter of said Section 10; and running thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 10 for a distance of 1320 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
