WOOD BURNING STOVES

Chimney Smoke Reduction Incentive Program Eligible applicants can receive a rebate for \$500 or \$600, and if income eligible up to \$2500, to offset the cost of replacing an old, non-EPA certified wood stove or fireplace insert with a cleaner-burning stove or insert.  Placer Resource Conservation District's (Placer RCD) Chipper Program will resume services on Thursday, October 1, 2020. Although the program experienced a temporary pause this spring due to challenges related to the COVID-19 pandemic, Placer RCD is grateful for the community's patience and excited to announce its reopening.

Due to increases in project costs, the cost-share price has been raised to \$80/hour. **Landowners are required to pay for a minimum of one hour of work. Service fees may be waived for community members with a disabled person vehicle placard or a household income not exceeding the "Very Low Limit" defined by Placer County Department of Housing and Urban Development.** Please call the phone number below and leave a message with your name, site address, phone number, and location of the brush pile to request service. Program participation is encouraged, however, due to high demand, landowners may experience extended wait times from when the request is received until the brush is processed. The Chipper Program is the District's most popular and utilized program. Hundreds of community members have taken advantage of this low-cost, residential chipping service. HELPFUL HINT

How to Safely Boil Water in the Microwave

Choose a microwave-safe bowl. Glass or ceramic bowls work best.
 Pour water into an unsealed container. Do not seal or cover the container.
 Place a non-metallic object in the container. This could be a chopstick or popsicle stick, which will prevent the water from super heating.
 Heat in short intervals. Stir after each 1–2-minute interval until the water has boiled
 Tap the side of the bowl to check for super heating. Tapping the side of the bowl disturbs the water molecules and releases trapped heat.
 Carefully remove the container. Use hot pads to avoid burning

Storage Tanks Project Update

The 1st of 2 Water storage tanks was completed and put online in January.

The existing reservoir has been drained and the contractor is preparing the foundation for Tank #2.

Construction of Tank 2 will begin the third week of March through late April after which it will be painted, disinfected and tested prior to filling.

The remainder of the site piping will be constructed during March and early April with tie-ins to existing piping after disinfection and testing. The majority of the project should be completed by June 1st with final grading, fencing and landscaping being completed there after.
