



Currently Christian Valley Park Community Service District receives approximately \$60,000 a year from our property taxes for non county road maintenance. This includes replacing signs as needed, the striping of some roads (Mary Lane to McElroy, Gregg Way, Allen Drive and Pondorex Road) as well as for the trimming of any trees that have become a safety hazard.

Helpful Hint: How to Detect Toilet Tank Leaks

Toilet leaks may be easy to repair, but detecting them can be a great challenge, especially when they are completely silent. It's nerve racking to view a water bill and see the amount double or triple what you normally pay. Here is a very quick and easy method to detect a toilet leak.

- 1.) Drop about 4 to 5 food coloring drops in the toilet tank.

 You may want to use a dark color
- 2.) Replace the toilet lid and wait 20 to 30 minutes.
- 3.) Survey the toilet bowl. If the water is clear, there is no leak. If the water has changed color, there is a leak present

Treatment Plant Improvements Tank Project Update

The first of the two 750 thousand gallon holding Tanks has been completed. The next phase in order to bring the tank online it will be cleaned, filled, dis-infected and the water will be tested.


The contractor is the process of pressure testing the new onsite pipelines after which they will be tested for water quality. Once the water is verified to be clean and safe for drinking, at that point the pipes will be connected to the existing system, and Tank 1 will be online. Tank 1 will be operated in conjunction with the existing reservoir for about a week to ensure all systems are operating properly.

Once all aspects of systems operation are verified, decommissioning of the existing inground reservoir will consist of being drained and demolished.

The removed reservoir's footprint will be evaluated to confirm the foundation design for Tank 2. The electrical and controls are being installed to provide automatic control and alarm functions. Grading, piping and foundation work for Tank 2 will begin in late December/early January, weather permitting.
